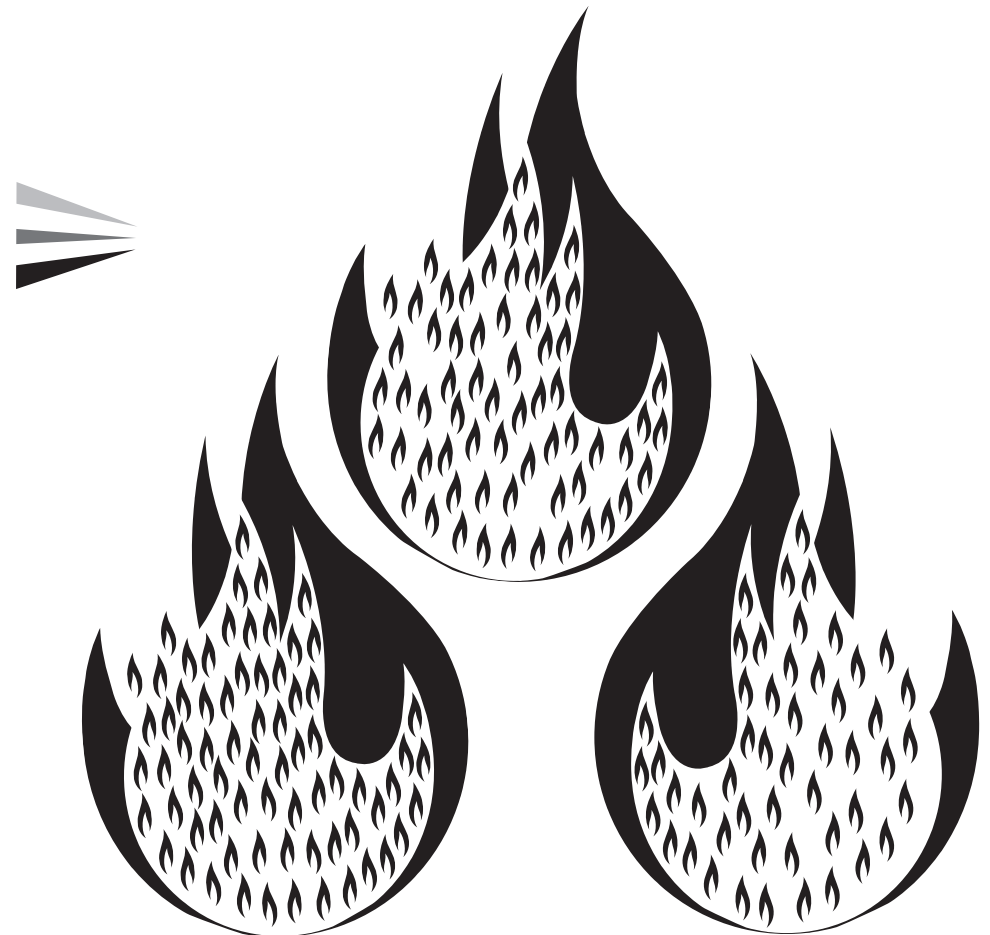

## Finding Five 5 5 5 5 5 5 5

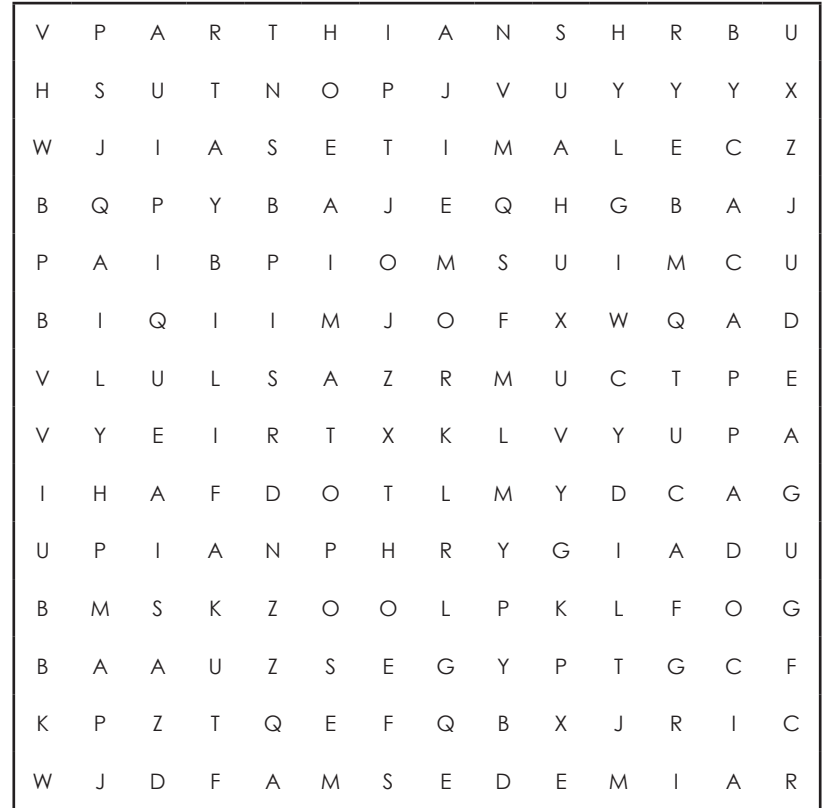
When pent, penta, or pente starts a word, it means five. See if you can match up these pent- words with their meanings.

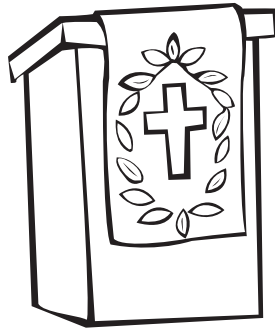

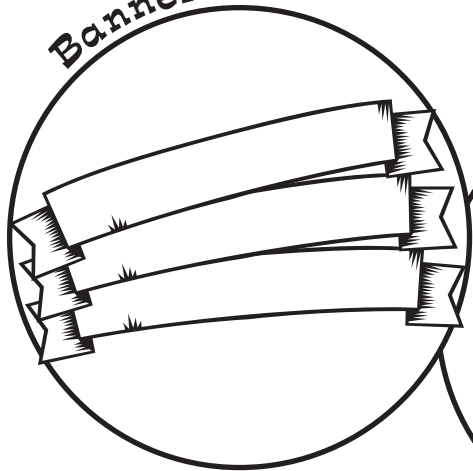

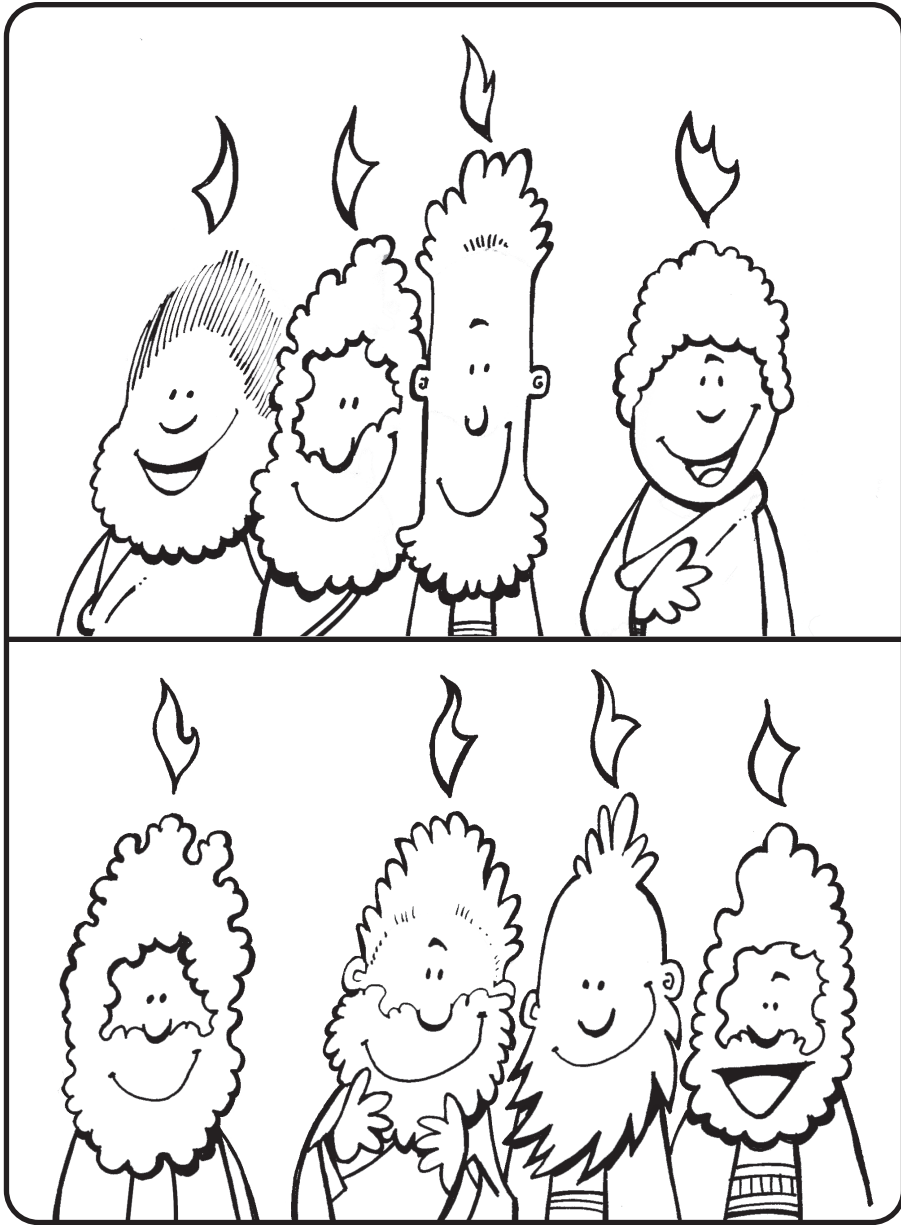
# PRE-READER
