Saint Andrew Prayer List

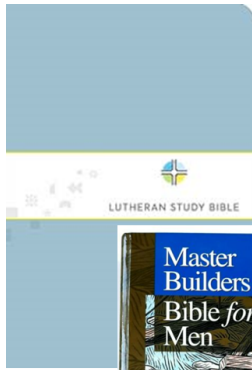
