ECSW Synod Assembly 2026

The synodical expression of the church will meet in Oshkosh June 4-6 to worship, conduct church business, and learn more about the 2026 theme "To Strive for Justice and Peace for All the Earth". This year is also the bishop election. Please hold in prayer Bishop Anne Edison-Albright who has indicated her willingness to be considered for re-election to a second term and those candidates who are also open to serving as the bishop of the ECSW (East Central Synod of Wisconsin).

Wisconsin is made up of 6 synods, the ECSW being the largest. Within our synod, there are 6 conferences which currently comprise 111 congregations. Rib Mountain State Park

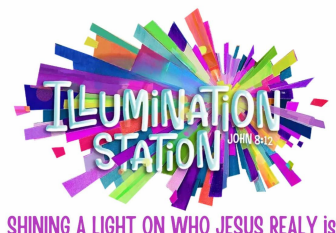

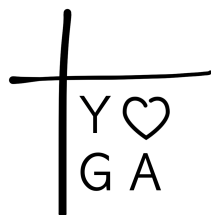
Illumination Station

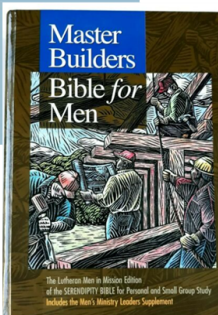
